

## Associate Director

The Center for Educational Testing and Evaluation at the University of Kansas is seeking a qualified Associate Director who will, under the general direction of the Director, be responsible for management and implementation of all tasks required for ongoing support of the Kansas State Assessment Program, including the General Assessment, Kansas Alternate Assessment (KAA), Kansas Assessment of Modified Measures (KAMM), Kansas English Language Proficiency Assessment (KELPA), Kansas Interim Assessment, and Kansas Formative Assessment. Tasks include operational psychometric analyses, logistics, and applied research. The incumbent will be responsible for the management of a small number of professional staff and graduate students.

### Required Qualifications:

1. Doctorate in educational or psychological testing and measurement, statistics, or quantitative research design
2. Eight years experience performing psychometric work on large-scale assessment programs demonstrating a pattern of increasing responsibilities
3. Five years practical experience applying item response theory including the three-parameter logistic model
4. Three years experience explaining psychometric issues to non-technical audiences
5. Two years experience managing staff on a project or line basis
