The University of North Carolina at Greensboro (www.uncg.edu), School of Health and Human Performance (HHP) (www.uncg.edu/hhp) invites applications for either a tenure track (tenure eligible) or non tenure track Quantitative Methodologist in the Department of Public Health Education. This person will assist in the expansion of our research and graduate programs within the School across four departments and two centers. Increased research productivity including funded research is a central goal of the school; quantitative support for our researchers is critical to meeting that goal. The faculty is currently funded by NIAMS, NIDA, NCI, CDC and numerous private foundations and state agencies.

Responsibilities

The primary responsibility for the successful candidate will be to provide collegial consultation in appropriate design and analysis, data analysis in support of manuscript preparation, methodological support in grant application preparation, and hands on statistical analyses. In addition, the successful candidate may teach statistics courses in the master's and doctoral programs; serve on student theses and dissertation supervisory committees. The successful tenure track candidate will be expected to pursue his or her area of methodological or substantive research in conjunction with responsibilities discussed above.

Qualifications:

A doctoral degree is required; a PhD in quantitative methods or related fields such as Quantitative Psychology is strongly preferred. A record of publication, grant activity, and interdisciplinary work is expected. Teaching experience at the graduate level is desired.
