This position will work with large datasets using a range of statistical programming languages or packages such as R, SAS, SPSS or Python. To successfully undertake this position requires expertise in a variety of applied psychometric and statistical models for analysing assessment data, including the ability to efficiently apply and evaluate different Item Response Models. At times knowledge of multilevel modelling, Structural Equation Modelling, contemporary machine learning methodologies and approaches to the analysis of log-file data may be employed to resolve analytical issues relating to educational data sets.
