DETAILED METRO INSTRUCTIONS

On the excursion day, attendees may consider going to enjoy DC early on their own! Conference attendees can either meet at the spy museum using the metro OR come back using the metro and then jump on one of the buses provided between 6:15 p.m.-8:00 p.m. located at the College Park Marriott Hotel.

For your own planned trip to D.C., here are some detailed metro directions:

Route A: Stamp Union-National Mall.

Option #1 (Note that the No Metrorail service between College Park - UMD Metro Station and Fort Totten on the Green Line after July 24. Free shuttle bus service will be available from College Park - UMD Metro Station to Fort Totten Metro Station.)

- Walk to Regents Drive Garage bus stop (location ID #10003) 2min
- Take UMD Shuttle 104 College Park Metro. Get off at College Park UMD Metro
 Station Bay E bus stop (location ID #36469) 8min
- Take the free shuttle Green Line Shuttle OR Greenbelt Fort Totten Limited to Fort Totten Metro Station
- Take the Green line, Branch Ave direction, and get off at Archives-Navy Memorial-Penn Quarter OR L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station - 16min
- You can also **transfer** to Orange/Blue/Silver line at L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station and get off at **Smithsonian Metro Station**.
- Walk toward the tourist attractions.

Option #2

- Walk to Stadium Dr & #4136 Yahentamitsi Dining Hall bus stop (stop ID: 3004394)
 6min
- Take Route F6 Fort Totten. Get off at Fort Totten Station & Alighting Only -39min
- Walk to Fort Totten Metro Station 3min
- Take the **Green line**, Branch Ave direction, and get off at **Archives-Navy Memorial- Penn Quarter** OR **L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station** 16min
- You can also transfer to Orange/Blue/Silver line at L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station and get off at Smithsonian Metro Station.
- Walk toward the tourist attractions.


Route B: The Hotel-National Mall.

- Walk to Campus Drive / Baltimore Avenue bus stop 1min
- Take Route 17 Ikea. Get off at College Park UMD Metro Station Bay F bus stop - 3min
- Take the free shuttle Green Line Shuttle OR Greenbelt Fort Totten Limited to Fort Totten Metro Station
- Take the Green line, Branch Ave direction, and get off at Archives-Navy Memorial-Penn Quarter OR L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station - 16min

- You can also **transfer** to Orange/Blue/Silver line at L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station and get off at **Smithsonian Metro Station**.
- Walk toward the tourist attractions.

Route C: The College Park Marriott-National Mall.

- Walk to Adelphi Rd & Tulane Dr bus stop (stop ID: 3002147) 4min
- Take Route F6 Fort Totten. Get off at Fort Totten Station & Alighting Only 34min
- Walk to Fort Totten Metro Station 3min
- Take the **Green line**, Branch Ave direction, and get off at **Archives-Navy Memorial- Penn Quarter** OR **L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station** 16min
- You can also **transfer** to Orange/Blue/Silver lines at L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station and get off at **Smithsonian Metro Station**.
- Walk toward the tourist attractions.

Appendix B: Metro Fare

You can either buy a ticket or a SmarTrip® card to take the Metro rail and Metro bus in DMV (DC-Maryland-Virginia) area. Fares vary by time of day, day of the week the trip is taken, and the distance traveled between the origin and destination stations.

- The regular fare for Metro rail on weekdays (Mon. Fri., 5.00 a.m. 9.30 p.m.) is \$2 to \$6. The regular fare on weekdays after 9.30 p.m. and on weekends is \$2. The Metro Rail fare is estimated to be \$2.9 from Fort Totten to L'Enfant Plaza.
- The regular fare is \$2 for regular routes and \$4.25 for express routes (with X on the number of route).
- Reduced Fares are available for qualifying seniors, people with disabilities, and customers enrolled in Metro Lift: https://www.wmata.com/fares/Reduced-Fare-Programs

Appendix C: How to purchase a Metro Rail ticket

- Buy a ticket:
 - You can purchase a ticket on the vendor machine at the metro station using cash or credit card.
- SmarTrip® and fares can be purchased at the following:
 - Mobile: SmarTrip app + SmarTrip in Apple Wallet and Google Pay
 - Online: Purchase new cards in the SmarTrip store or add fare to your registered card by logging in to your account
 - Rail Stations: Fare Vending Machines located in Metrorail stations
 - o Retail Outlets: Commuter stores and retail outlets


Appendix D: How to purchase a Metro bus ticket

- Make cashless payments using <u>SmarTrip Mobile</u> or plastic SmarTrip Cards
- Cash payments are accepted on most routes but must be made with exact change bus operators do not carry cash

Appendix E: Transfers

- Metrobus to Metrobus: Free, unlimited transfers within a 2-hour period
- Metrobus to Metrorail/Metrorail to Metrobus: Free transfers (\$2 discount) within a 2-hour period. \$2 discount does not cover the cost of transferring to/from express routes.
 SmarTrip card required.
- Farragut Crossing: Free transfer between the Red line and Orange, Silver and Blue lines by exiting and entering through Farragut West and Farragut North

Appendix F: Road Map from L'Enfant Plaza to International Spy Museum (Washington D.C.) Attendees can use the METRO to get to D.C. and plan to meet directly at the Spy Museum, or they may come back to College Park after exploring D.C. and then catch the provided transportation to the museum located at the College Park Marriott anytime between 6:15 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. If attendees choose to meet directly at the Spy Museum (700 L'Enfant Plaza SW). It's approximately a 6-minute walk from the L'Enfant Plaza (Metro Station). The Closing Excursion Reception event located at the Spy Museum will take place on the evening of Friday, July 28, from 7:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m.
